Cadyn Wright was recently recognized at the Montana Stock Growers Convention for having one of the Top Five steers in the statewide **2025 Steer of Merit** competition. Cadyn's 2025 fair market steer placed 4th overall in the Ultrasound Division (out of 935 entries!). This steer was Home Raised! That's amazing!

The Carbon County 4-H Sr. Livestock Judging Team placed 2nd at Montana 4-H Congress and qualified to compete at the National Western Stock Show this month. Team members Molly Miller, Tassyn Wright, Nevaeh Rupprecht and Harleigh Donnelly travelled to Denver with coaches Amber Elliott and Luke Miller to compete. They practiced at several ranches and feedlots along the way to keep their skills sharp. The team placed 15th overall, 9th in goats, 10th in cattle, Tassyn Wright was 34th High Individual.

Animal Quality Assurance Training

County animal quality assurance (QA) requirements have changed. All 1st year 4-H/FFA members planning to exhibit an animal at fair are required to attend QA this spring. This includes ALL animal projects! New this year: Members will only need to attend QA training once per age division (Novice 8-10, Junior 11-13, Senior 14+, FFA). Call the office if you are unsure of your QA status. FFA members are responsible for tracking their requirements. **There are only 2 scheduled QA trainings this year - March 11 & April 12; plan accordingly!**
