7.	I understand I will need to take the Market Animal Quality Assurance training every two years to remain certified.
8.	I understand the livestock sale expense deductions, as approved by the Livestock Council, will be deducted from my sale check.
9.	During the fair, I will complete and hang my stall poster in its respective place by the end of Thursday, compete in the appropriate showmanship contest and work in the 4-H Chuckwagon as assigned.
