Important Upcoming Dates

Project Drop/Add deadline - June 1, 2025

Jan French Memorial Scholarship applications Due June 1, 2025. Application information can be found on our website.

Colt R. Memorial Project Scholarship applications due June 1, 2025. Eligibility and application can be found on our website. This is a project scholarship and can be used towards expenses related to your 4-H project.

Required Horse Forms are due June 1, 2025. Forms can be found on our website or with your Horse leader.

MT 4-H Pre-Congress and Congress registration closes on June 15. MT 4-H Congress dates are July 8-11. Pre-Congress begins July 6.

Buyer Letter Invitation Tips

Sending potential buyers a personal invitation to the 4-H Livestock Sale is a great way to get bidders to come and possibly purchase your market animal. Your letter should include an introduction of yourself and your project. Be sure to include the date, time and location of the sale. Let them know that they can contact the JB Co. Ext. Office for a buyer's brochure if they'd like one. Close your letter with a paragraph about your plans for the market sale proceeds and thank them for their time to read your letter and consider attending the sale.



PROJECT INTERVIEW TIPS

- Bring your complete and up-to-date record book with you. Your record book should be neat and organized. Include your My 4-H Year as well as your project journal and complete financial records.
- Your record book can be either handwritten or you can download the fillable pdf forms from our website. Handwritten record books should be written by the 4-H member only. If accommodations are necessary, a parent may assist the member.
- Project Interview Judges will be assessing verbal and non verbal skills, project knowledge, listening skills, thoroughness, etc.
- Indoor project interview judges will also be looking for things such as the workmanship, design, general appearance, etc. of the exhibit.
- Give yourself plenty of time to prepare for your interview so you don't feel rushed. Arrive early and look through your record book before beginning your interview.
- Dress nicely for your interview. Presenting to the judge with a clean and neat appearance can set a positive tone for your interview.
- Listen closely to the questions and take a breath before you answer. It's okay to pause and think about your answer before speaking. If you aren't sure of an answer, it's okay to tell the judge that you are uncertain. Offer the judge what you think the answer might be and why.
- Let the judge know what you've learned, what you enjoyed about the project and if you intend to continue on with the project in the future.
- Don't be afraid to talk about the things that you tried and weren't as successful with. Share with them what you learned from the experience.
- Talk about your 4-H experiences including service work, leadership activities, camps and so on.
- Be sure to make good eye contact with your judge, smile and shake their hand. Thank them for their time.
- Most of all, be confident in yourself! It's likely that your judge was sitting right where you are when they were in 4-H.

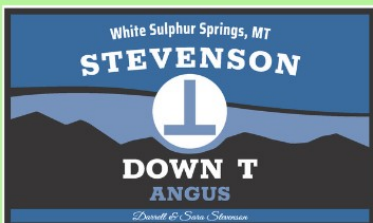
