RECORD BOOKS

COMPLETED AND SIGNED BOOKS ARE

SEPTEMBER 1ST.

The final yearly task for each member is the completion and submission of a project Record Book. A Record Book is required for each project that the 4-H member completed during the year. All record books are judged and awards are given in various categories. Just a reminder, that without a completed Record Book turned in on time, the member does not receive credit for the project. This also means that they can not participate in that project next 4-H year. As an example, a member who completed a beef project but did not turn in a record book would not be eligible to do a beef project in 2027, including selling at the 2027 livestock sale. Record Books are a very important part of the 4-H project.

A complete Record Book includes a My 4-H Year as well as a project journal/financial record. All forms can be found on the 4-H Forms page of our website or stop by our office for a copy.
